

Science North and Dynamic Earth extend hours for the summer and bring in new experiences

(SUDBURY, ON) – Science North and Dynamic Earth are now open from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. seven days a week until September 2, 2024. All summer, Science North will feature the special exhibition, Extreme Sports, new IMAX movies, and Planetarium shows. Dynamic Earth's recently renovated lapidary lab will compliment returning favourites like the underground mine tour and outdoor science park.

At Science North, Extreme Sports: Beyond Human Limits features 16 sports that bring science and adventure together in a way that sparks curiosity. Visitors can look forward to challenging their balance on a high line, moving through a parkour course, or scaling a climbing wall. For a truly unique experience, feel what it's like to move on the Moon with a special harness simulating the Moon's gravity in the Moonwalk exhibit on the fourth floor of the science centre.

Over at Dynamic Earth, rocks and minerals take centre stage and rock nerds can create their own treasure to take home in the lapidary lab. For families looking to spend the day at Dynamic Earth, put on a hard hat and descend seven storeys underground to walk in the footsteps of Sudbury's miners before getting some fresh air in the outdoor science park.
